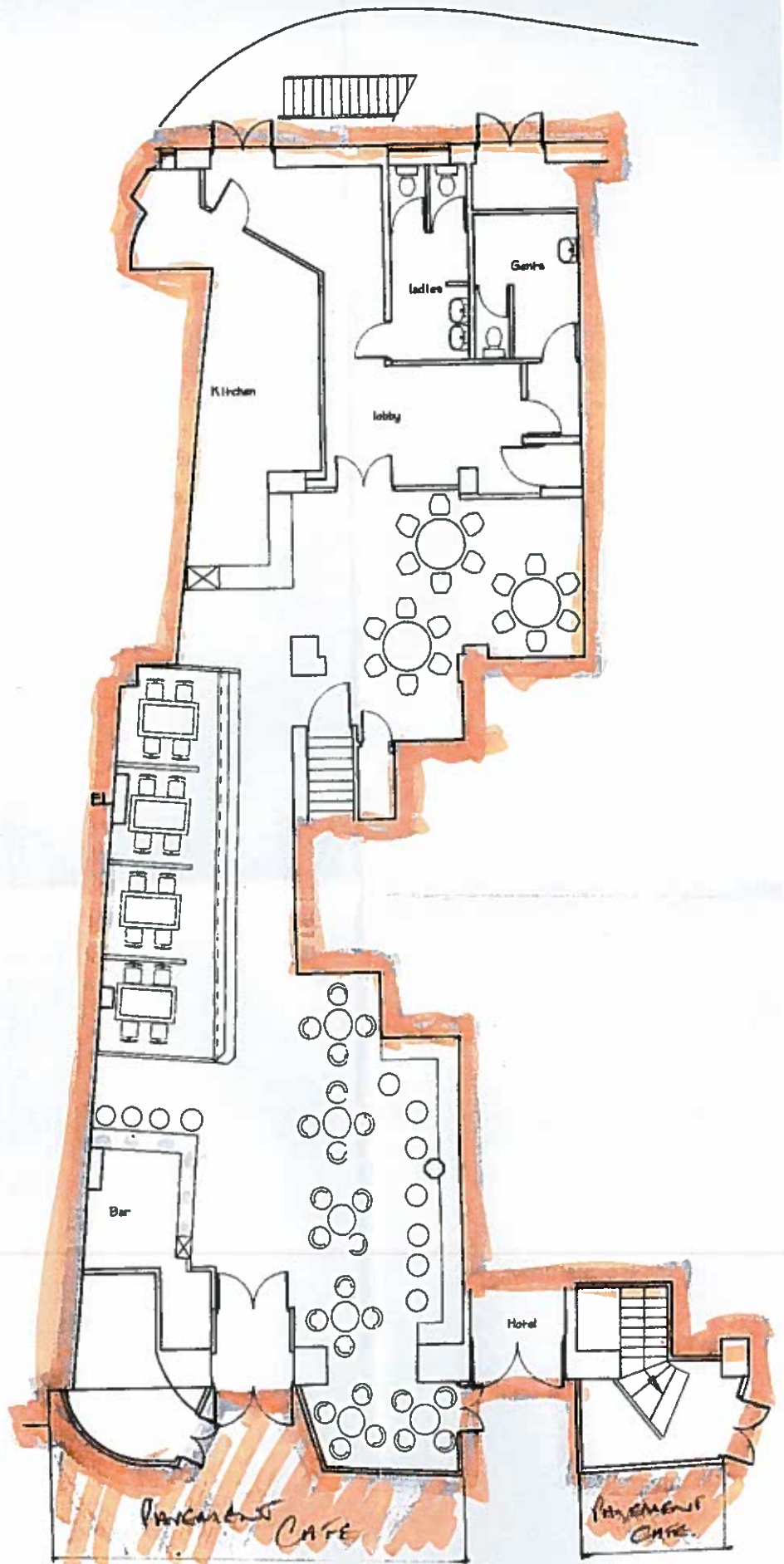

Crime and disorder


1. On every occasion that the premises sells alcohol after midnight and then closes after 00.30, SIA door staff will be employed from 22.00 until closing.
2. There shall be no entry or re entry of patrons after 02.00.
3. On every operational day when door stewards are required who are employed for front of house duties must wear high visibility jackets for the entirety of their duty.

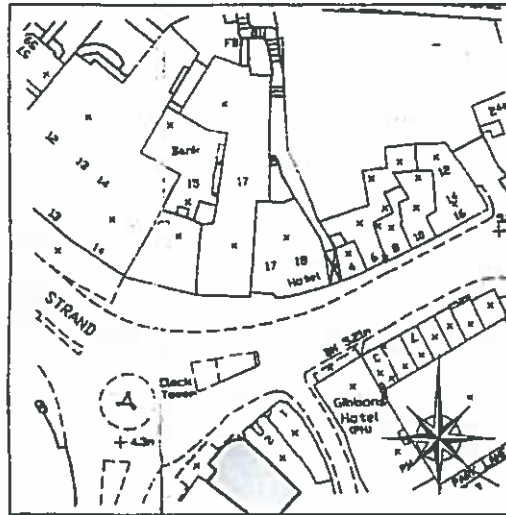
Prevention Of Public Nuisance

1. Noise or vibration should not emanate from the premises such as to cause persons in the neighbourhood to be unreasonably disturbed.
2. All regulated entertainment shall be played through a limiter which is set at a level agreed with the local responsible authority for public nuisance. The limiter shall be made tamper proof and any adjustments to sound levels shall only be made in consultation with the responsible authority for public nuisance.
3. The level of amplified music shall be reduced by 50% of the agreed level set by the noise limiter at 01.30 on Friday and Saturday nights hours until closing.
4. No changes that increase the level of volume to the public address system shall be made without prior consultation of the local Environmental Health Department, this includes moving of speakers, addition or removal of any equipment and the use of guest acts/DJs own equipment.

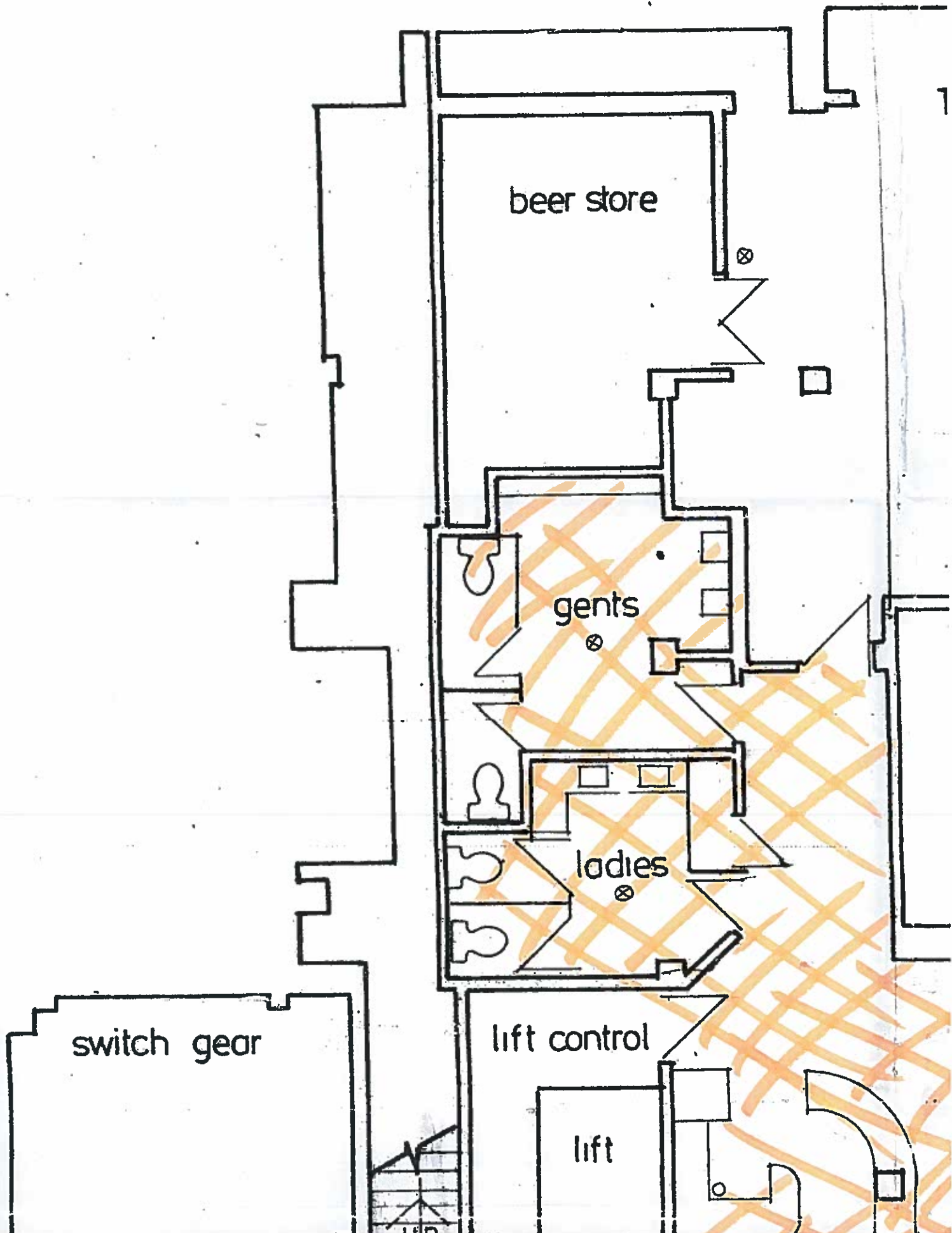

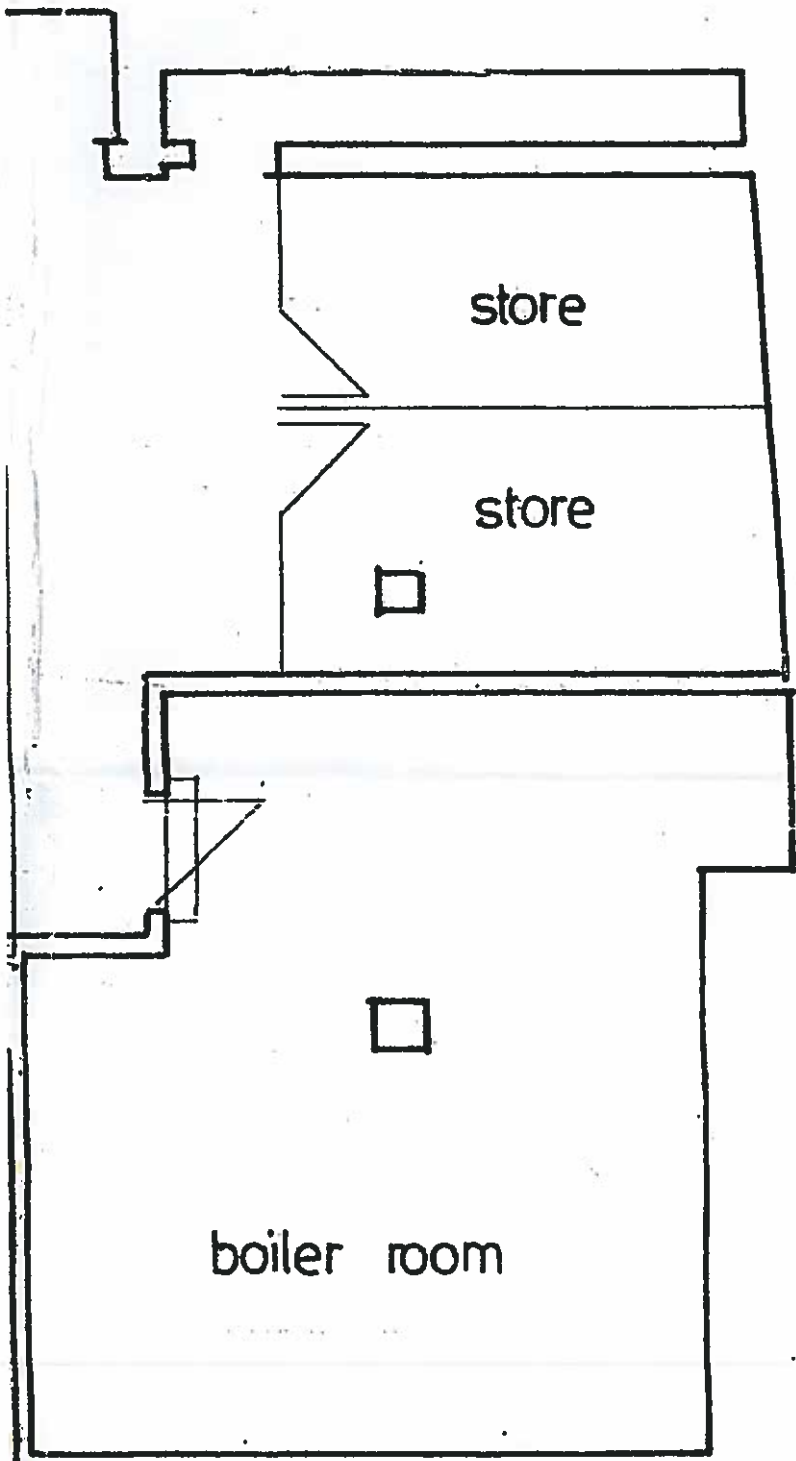

Provide new or upgrade the existing system to BS 5839 type L2 standard with heat detectors and break glass call points located as noted, provide warning bells and or audio warning linked to sound system to be audible throughout the building with all doors closed. FD30s fire doors with vision panels to be provided to separate the lobbies and stairwell off all as noted. Emergency lighting to be provided to BS 5266 and all signage to be installed to BS 5266. Alarms and system to be installed and commissioned by a competent person and all certificates to be passed to the Building Inspector upon completion
