What do panels do?

Who is on the Panel?

We have a pool of members and use three members to sit on our panels. There are two types of Panel Member – those with experience of education (e.g. a parent of a child at school or somebody with experience in education) and "lay" members (i.e. those without any experience in education).

Yes, all new Panel Members have to receive training before taking part in an appeal. After this initial training Panel Members will receive regular refresher training.

Appeals can only be heard during school terms, the appeals are arranged so that there would be a half a day to a days worth of appeals at any one time. Appeals tend to peak at the time when parents are notified of the primary and secondary schools that their children will be attending, this is usually May to July.

Do I get paid for serving on the Panel?

Whilst service on the Panel is voluntary, members are entitled to expenses (such as travel) and refreshments are usually provided for Panel Members throughout the day for sessions held in person. Please note most of our appeals are held virtually via Zoom.
